

What Can I Bring?

Clothing: Maximum amount of clothing.

- ☒ 8-12 Socks
- ☒ 6-10 Full Underwear (No Thongs)
- ☒ 3 Bras
- ☒ 6 Jeans/Pants
- ☒ 10 Tops: appropriate t-shirt or long sleeve shirts
- ☒ 2 Sweat pant/pajama pants (No writing across rear of pants)
- ☒ 3 Sweatshirts/hoodies (If strings are in hoodies, they may be removed for safety)
- ☒ 1 Pairs of tennis shoes
- ☒ 1 Swim trunks or, one piece bathing suit

Seasonal:

- ☒ 1 Fall jacket
- ☒ 1 Warm winter coat
- ☒ 1 Warm pair of gloves
- ☒ 1 Winter hat
- ☒ 1 Snow pants
- ☒ 1 Pair of winter boots
- ☒ 5 Shorts (At or right above knee)
- ☒ 1 Pair of sandals

Optional Items to Bring:

- ☒ 1 Pair of slippers
- ☒ Family Photos, copies preferred
- ☒ Stationary/Journals (No spiral notebooks)
- ☒ Sketch books (non-spiral)
- ☒ Make-up (No glass or mirrors on make-up)
- ☒ Perfume/Cologne (No aerosol or glass containers)
- ☒ Comfort items such as: 1-stuffed animal, pillow or blanket. (Items will be washed so must be able to go through washing and drying.)

Personal hygiene items are approved to bring to the North Homes to support healthy routines and bring the comfort of home. These items will be placed in a hygiene bin and used daily. Any other hygiene items will need to be approved through case manager. Culturally specific hygiene items will be provided based on need.

All belongings must have the resident's initials on them as identification. All items will be inventoried by staff and resident. North Homes has a limited storage capacity and any additional items may need to be sent back with family.

Residents are responsible for their belongings. Residents may not borrow, lend, sell, trade or give away personal belongings. We suggest that residents keep valuable items at home. North Homes does not assume responsibility for items which are willfully misplaced, mishandled or destroyed by residents. When residents return from a home passes, they are recommended to bring back the same amount of items that they left with. All belongings and residents are searched at intake and after each home passes before entering the North Homes units.

What Can't I Bring

- ❏ Alcohol based products
- ❏ Aerosol spray cans
- ❏ Electronics-Videotapes/CD's/DVD's/Video Game Consoles/TV's
- ❏ Cell phones/MP3 Players/I-pods/I-pads, Tablets
- ❏ Personal computers
- ❏ Aftershave
- ❏ Hair spray
- ❏ Weapons
- ❏ Razors, razor blades
- ❏ Scissors
- ❏ Tweezers, nail clippers (provided by staff)
- ❏ Matches, lighters
- ❏ Cameras
- ❏ Video Cameras
- ❏ Pins or sharp objects
- ❏ Tobacco, alcohol or chemicals or pictures of the above.
- ❏ Magnets
- ❏ Pictures depicting provocative or gang images.
- ❏ Non-prescription medication
- ❏ Any clothing that is revealing(at the North Homes discretion)

If you bring in something that you can't have it will be inventoried by staff and safely placed in intake room until you are able to bring it home or until you are discharged from North Homes. A responsive intervention may occur depending on situation and item brought into North Homes.
